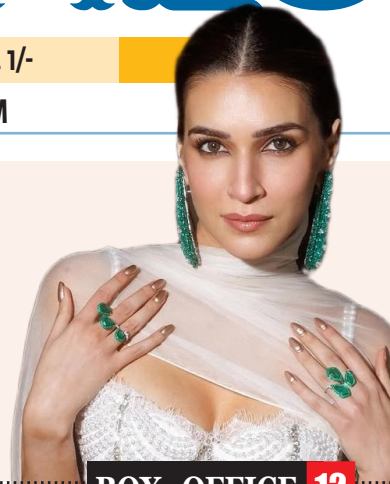

Kaleshwaram Probe: CM Slams BJP-BRS 'Collusion'

HYDERABAD, MARCH 29

Chief Minister Shri A Revanth Reddy lambasted the BJP for not ordering a CBI probe in the Kaleshwaram project despite the state government making several pleas for the last one year.

Speaking in the Assembly, the Chief Minister pointed out that Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Union Home minister Amit Shah openly made a statement that the KCR family siphoned off funds allocated for the Kaleshwaram project. It was Union Minister G Kishan Reddy who also commented that the Centre is ready to order the CBI probe and put KCR and Harish Rao behind the bars within 48 hours of the state government being ready. "Anticipating the centre will react promptly, the state government wrote a letter to the centre requesting to handover Kaleshwaram scam to CBI," CM Revanth Reddy said wondering why there is no official reply from

the union government for a CBI probe.

The Chief Minister alleged that the BRS and BJP colluded in the Kaleshwaram scam. In a quid pro quo, the BRS transferred the vote bank to BJP in the Lok Sabha elections in Telangana state. The CM appealed to the BJP leaders to give suggestions only after the arrest of KCR and Harish Rao. CM Revanth Reddy also

levelled allegations against Harish Rao's brother Mahesh Rao threatened the owners of private Industries and grabbed hundreds of acres of lands by using Dharani portal at Balanagar Mahabubnagar district. The government is ready to constitute a House Committee to probe into the land encroached if the BRS leaders - KTR and Vankatrami Reddy are ready.

Assembly passes Bill to ensure dignity for senior citizens

Hyderabad, Mar 29:

The Telangana Assembly on Sunday passed the 'Telangana Employees Accountability and Monitoring of Parental Support Bill, 2026', aimed at ensuring dignity for senior citizens. Chief Minister A Revanth Reddy said the Bill seeks to go beyond existing central legislation. He noted that the country already has a national law, the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007. However, the State's new Bill will also cover public representatives and private employees. The Bill mandates that public representatives, government employees, and private employees care for their elderly parents.

Modi Attacks LDF, UDF

Expresses Confidence in NDA's Prospects in Kerala

PALAKKAD, MARCH 29

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Sunday launched a sharp attack on both the CPI(M)-led Left Democratic Front (LDF) and the Congress-led United Democratic Front (UDF), accusing them of corruption and misgovernance. Addressing a rally in Palakkad ahead of the April 9 polls, he asserted that the BJP-led National Democratic Alliance (NDA) is poised to form the next government in Kerala. Claiming a shift in the

state's political climate, Modi said there is growing support for the BJP and NDA among youth, women, and farmers. He expressed confidence that the alliance would secure victory and "leave no stone unturned" in serving the people of Kerala.

In a scathing critique, the Prime Minister alleged that the LDF and UDF have alternated in power through a "mutual arrangement," prioritizing personal gains over public welfare. He claimed

that both alliances have effectively "looted" the state while avoiding action against each other's alleged corruption.

Referring to accusations by the two fronts that each other acts as the BJP's "B-team," Modi said this implicitly establishes the BJP as the "real A-team" in Kerala politics. He further alleged that both alliances are targeting the BJP out of fear that their alleged irregularities would be exposed if the NDA comes to power.

A MAJOR POLITICAL SHIFT IS TAKING PLACE IN TELANGANA

HYDERABAD, MAR 29

In a significant boost to the BJP in Telangana ahead of the upcoming GHMC elections, a large number of youth, local welfare associations, and leaders from different parties have been joining the saffron fold attracting with visionary leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi. A large number of youth and members of local welfare associations today joined in BJP in the presence of BJP state president N Ramchander Rao at Dilsukhgar.

Metro Takeover: KTR Slams Govt for ₹15,000 Cr Debt Burden



HYDERABAD, MARCH 29

BRS party Working President and MLA KTR today lashed out at CM Revanth Reddy and accused him of shamelessly presenting false figures regarding the Metro rail project takeover on the floor of the state Assembly. He alleged that the Congress government was forcibly burdening the people of Telangana with a debt of ₹15,000 crore owed by the private entity L&T Company. The BRS party members staged a protest demanding the constitution of a House Committee to investigate a mining company involved in illegal activities. The BRS party MLAs and MLCs gathered at Gun Park to protest demanding action against the illegal stone crushers operated by Raghav Constructions. Former Ministers KTR and Harish Rao participated in this protest. On this occasion, they marched in a protest rally from Gun Park to the Assembly.

CM Revanth colluded with KTR: Bandi Sanjay



Hyderabad, March 29 (NSS): Union Minister of State for Home Affairs Bandi Sanjay Kumar has leveled sensational allegations and claimed that Chief Minister Revanth Reddy had colluded with BRS party Working President KTR and added that it was precisely why Revanth Reddy was refraining from pursuing the corruption cases pending against KTR. He alleged that Revanth Reddy was playing the role of a mediator to broker reconciliation between Kalvakuntla Kavitha and KTR. He remarked that Revanth Reddy was selectively targeting only former Minister Harish Rao and was limiting his discourse to corruption involving merely a specific segment of the Kaleshwaram project. He asserted that the inquiry had been restricted solely to the alleged corruption at Annaram, Sundilla and Medigadda pump houses out of fear that a comprehensive investigation into the entire ₹1 lakh crore corruption scandal surrounding Kaleshwaram would expose the full extent of the malfeasance.
