

Awareness Program on Narcotics

Cyber Security, and Women's Safety at Medici Institute of Medical Sciences, Ghanpur

As part of efforts to prevent the sale, purchase, and consumption of narcotic substances in Telangana, the Eagle Police Department organized a special awareness program today at the premises of Medici Institute of Medical Sciences.

The session was conducted under the leadership of Shri P. Seetharam, Superintendent of Police, Eagle Police Department, along with Shri K. Saidulu, Deputy Superintendent of Police, and Shri P. "Telangana DGP inaugurates induction training program for Delhi Prisons staff at SICA"

The induction training program for Delhi Prisons staff was inaugurated today at the State Institute of Correctional Administration (SICA), Chanchalguda, by the Chief Guest, Shri B. Shivadhar Reddy, IPS, Director General of Police, Telangana. He was warmly received by Dr. Soumya Mishra, IPS, Director General of Prisons & Correctional Services, Telangana, along with senior officials and SICA faculty.

This training program stands as a symbol of inter-state coordination and mutual cooperation in correctional administration. In 2026, a total of 381 Delhi Prisons staff have been selected for training in phases. In the first phase launched today, 62 trainees are participating—61 from Delhi Prisons and 1 warder from Telangana. The batch includes 18 Assistant Superintendents (15 men and 3 women), 43 women warders/matrons, and 1 male warder from Telangana. Additionally, one male warder from the Andaman & Nicobar Islands will join during the course, further strengthening

inter-state collaboration. This comprehensive nine-month training program is designed to enhance professional skills, discipline, and a humanitarian outlook among trainees. The program includes:

Indoor (theoretical training): Prison rules, criminology, victimology & penology, psychology, sociology & social work, criminal laws, constitutional values & human rights, and the use of technology in prison administration.

Outdoor (physical & mental training): Physical exercises, parade as per BPR&D standards, yoga, and meditation.

Trainees will utilize SICA's modern facilities, including well-equipped classrooms, an air-conditioned auditorium, a well-stocked library, hostels accommodating 400 people, dedicated training grounds, a gym, and a hygienic dining hall.

In his address, Shri B. Shivadhar Reddy emphasized that the role of the prison department is highly important and not an easy task. He stated that prison service is not merely about locking inmates within four walls, but about reforming them and reintegrating them into society.

He advised trainees to uphold discipline, impartiality, and professionalism, and to treat inmates with dignity. He extended his best wishes to all trainees.

Dr. Soumya Mishra highlighted that training and inter-state cooperation are crucial in strengthening the correctional system. She noted that it is a matter of pride that the Director General of Delhi Prisons has entrusted SICA with training such a large number of staff, reflecting confidence in the institute's high standards.

She also mentioned SICA's past successful training programs, particularly for Tihar Jail staff and those conducted under BPR&D, which have earned national recognition. She emphasized that modern prison administration is moving toward reformative and rights-based approaches and encouraged trainees to contribute to positive societal change. The efforts of SICA faculty and experts were appreciated during the event.
